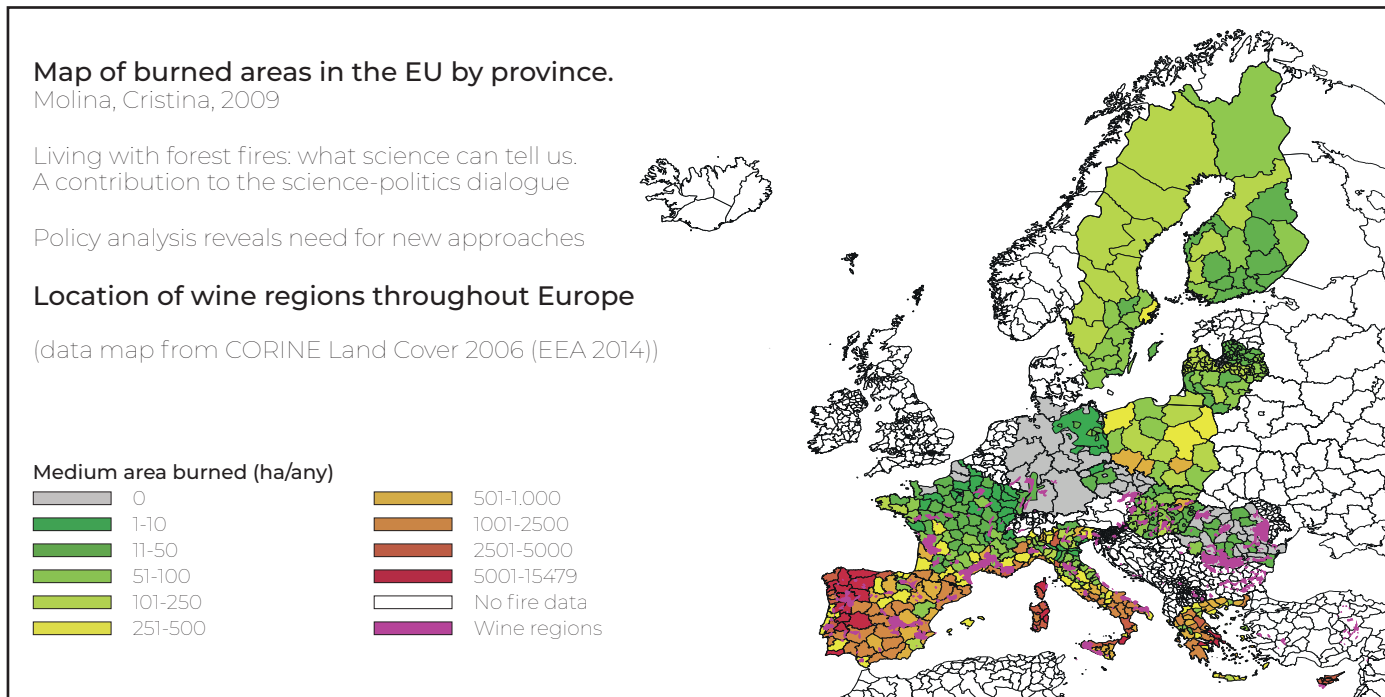
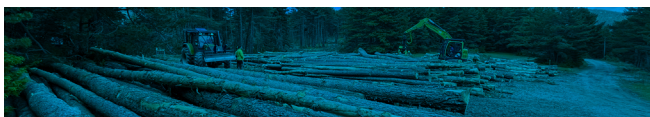
 Fire Wine





**FIRE WINE** is part of the European project Fire-RES of technological innovation for the promotion of resilient landscapes and the prevention of wild fires. The objective is to provide forest estates located in wine-growing territories with tools and models that stimulate the creation of landscapes prepared to prevent and reduce losses caused by wild fires.

The idea was born in Catalonia with the point to expand throughout the rest of the European territory and to develop a brand and a label to distinguish the wineries involved in improving forest management models.



The network is made up of wineries from Catalonia, Galicia, France, Portugal and Italy. Each wine region is unique. Its history, landscapes and socioeconomic reality define it, but the consequences of climate change and the increased risk of forest fires represent a shared challenge.

Considering wildfire risk management, vineyards can be especially useful in shaping the urban-rural interface to compensate for the abandonment of cultivated land and result in large continuous forests. The productive use of land shows a way to maintain the road



network and low biomass rates that help pre-vent large wild fires.

The **FIRE WINE** network shares successful experiences to improve quality standards and produces models that respect the landscape, biodiversity and the resilience of the environment. These models are now the best option in the fight to reduce the consequences of climate change. In this context, **FIRE WINE** offers a space for debate and creativity so that wineries can easily adapt to the new climate reality, where wine emerges as a product of responsibility and connection with the environment.
